## 1:00 - Call to Order

Eric Bond proposed a motion that Motor City Bass Anglers not be counted as present w/o representation. Mike Schoemann designated as their representative per cell phone call from James Hobson.

General Membership Board member elections:

After vote taking and tabulation, Jack Cahn, Jeff Cox, and Dave Reault were elected to board member seats.

### **By-Law Proposals: A vote was taken on two by-law proposal changes:**

Proposal 1:

Replace current introduction paragraphs 3,4,5 with the following two paragraphs:

Board of Directors meetings shall be regularly scheduled to occur at least once in each of the months of February, April, and November. General meetings with the chapter presidents shall occur promptly after each regularly scheduled board meeting. Additional meetings may be called at the discretion of the President or by a majority vote of the chapter presidents at any General meeting.

The Board of Directors shall annually elect by secret ballot a Federation President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The President shall then appoint from the federation membership, a Chairman of the youth activities committee, a chairman of the environmental committee, a chairman of the tournament committee, and any special committees as needed. The elections of officers shall be held no later than April 30, of each year.

This Proposal was voted on, with 14 yes votes, and 13 no votes, which constitutes not passing.

<u>Proposal 2:</u> Replace section VII paragraph A,B, and C with the following:

A: a bylaw change must be sent to the secretary by the last day of the month which occurs two months prior to any general meeting, to be considered during that meeting. More specifically, by December 31, Feb 28, and September 30, for the meetings in February, April, and November respectively.

B: The secretary will send out notice one month prior to that meeting

C: Each chapter president at that meeting will get one vote, each director will get one vote. A 2/3 majority will be required for the motion to pass.

This Proposal was voted on, with 18 Yes, and 8 No votes, which constitutes passing.

## **Treasury Highlights**

The board voted on a Treasury report format change for future meetings only reporting the current time period from the previous meeting until current. Anthony Adams propsed this, and it was seconded by Jack Cahn. Everyone present was in favor – item passed.

### **Money Handling:**

Multiple People can write checks, but communication in a timely manner is needed back to the Treasurer. Action Item – waiting for Dennis to provide an inventory all hard assets to the board. This inventory list to be kept/maintained by the secretary.

### **Income Taxes:**

2007 Income taxes are completed and filed. 2008 CY taxes are due to accountant and be filed by 5/15/09. CPA – Chuck Sowskalowski (Atto, MI). Fees are \$150/year

### **Board Elections**

Nominations from last meeting for members wishing to run for the 3 expiring board positions are in.

5 Total candidates are on the Ballot:

Jack Cahn – Eastside Bass Club, and current Board Secretary David Reault – Dakota Sports, and Current Board Member Jeff Cox – The Bass boys (Anthony Adams to speak on his behalf due to medical emergency) Derrek Cummings – The Bass Boys (Withdrawn) John Jazierski – Dakota Sports Eric Bond – Great Lakes Bass

Each candidate will speak briefly on why they should be elected to the board. Elections will be by roll call, with each club present getting 1 vote. Should there be a tie, the tie breaking process will be a commonly accepted method. The non-running board members (5) less the president will vote to break the tie.

Club dues must be fully paid prior to the April meeting to get full Voting and fishing rights for the 2009 season. A Ballot will be mailed and e-mailed to the club presidents and posted on the website shortly after 12/31/08.

After the April meeting vote, committees will be formed with a board member heading up each one. They will solicit additional membership (volunteers are encouraged) help to fulfill their deliverables for the upcoming season. These committees include, but are not limited to:

Youth State Tournament Sponsorship/fundraising/Product rebates Conservation Membership Communications/Marketing/Bylaws/Policies and procedures

Of the newly elected board members, the executive positions (Pres, VP, Secretary, Treasurer) will be voted on and put in place by 4/30/09.

## **By-Laws**

Currently there are some contradictions in the By-laws. In order to get these fixed, the current by-laws need to be voted on to change. By laws should be generic in nature, difficult to change, and opposing viewpoints heard. The details should be in our policies and procedures. A committee to address this will be put in place after the Board member vote in April. Proposed wording changes were submitted to the board, and will be voted upon at the April general membership meeting.

The current bylaws, and the proposed amendments, can be summarized as follows:

1. The board is currently required to meet regularly at least two times annually, plus one additional irregular meeting which is not followed by a general membership meeting. The first amendment will require the board to meet regularly at least three times annually, and allow for a general membership meeting to follow each of those meetings.

2. The adoption of amendments to the bylaws is currently permitted only during the April meeting. The second amendment will allow the adoption of amendments at any regularly scheduled meeting.

Per the bylaws, "Each club present at the April meeting will get one (1) vote, each board member will get one (1) vote. A 2/3 majority will be required for the motion to pass."

## 2009 Prize Money Disbursement

#### **Northern Divisional**

\$2000 minimum payout currently

80:20 split of prize winnings where:

20% - with a \$1000 minimum (\$500 ea) up to 20% total earmarked for the two state winners to attend the National Championship. Funds made up from general funds if payouts do not meet minimum set. Potential \$600 shortfall possible at minimum levels.

80% - \$150 expenses per boater paid from winnings (\$900 total) The balance then split equally 13 ways (12 team members plus alternate) \$85 each @ minimum.

Formula above is ok 5 room night – 7 rooms up till deadline Must double up occupancy If you room alone, individual pays 50% of room cost Lone room for President(or Alternate) ok
